

High River Alliance Church Worship Team

Thank you for considering the Worship Team as your area for ministry at High River Alliance Church. Perhaps you are just "checking us out". We encourage you to read through this brochure, come out to weekly practices with both teams, and-most importantly- prayerfully consider whether this is the place where God would have you serve Him and our church family. Our desire is to help you search for and discover your area of spiritual giftedness.

Worship Team Membership Procedure

Before you begin to lead with a team on a Sunday morning, a short interview with the Worship Team leader and Team coaches is required. This will include briefly sharing your journey to and with Christ and your reason for wanting to serve on the Worship Team.

A brief audition with the Worship Team leader and Team coaches is also necessary. This audition will include singing or playing a short portion of music. Participation at Worship Team rehearsals will play a part in evaluating your skill level as well.

If you are considered ready to lead on a Sunday morning, you will be placed on one of the two teams. The decision as to which team you will join will be made by the Worship Team leader and Team coaches- in dialogue with you- to determine which is the best fit for you.

Worship Team 13/Worship Team 24

Team 13 rehearses on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month and leads worship the following Sunday. Team 24 rehearses on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month and leads worship the following Sunday.

Worship Team Membership requires that you...

... are a follower of Jesus and in a growing relationship with Him. The fruit of the Spirit should be evidence of this relationship (Galatians 5:22-23).

... are committed to the vision, values and goals of HRAC and its leadership. This should be evident by either church membership or a period of regular, faithful attendance (a reference from your most recent pastor substitutes for in-house experience).

... have personal and spiritual integrity within the church to the extent that others are not hindered in their worship of the Lord.

... are musically inclined, having some natural and/or developed musical ability. You should be able to carry out your function with competence, confidence, and skill, allowing the church family to focus on the Lord.
